Guidelines for home-made entries

home-made = made by someone who earns little or no income from baking

professional = made by or on behalf of a catering establishment

- Please register your entry as soon as possible or by Thursday 9th October at the latest so that we know how many entries we have.
- Any kind of sweet dessert is permitted but must contain some British fruit in any form (apples, blackberries, pears, etc. or jam/juice made from them), locally sourced if possible.
- The minimum size must be 7 inches across or equivalent in order to make sure all judges get to try a bit of every dessert.
- Names of cake makers will not be matched to cakes until judging has finished, to prevent bias. Around 20 or more judges will be recruited from the event participants and popular vote will decide the winner.
- The contest winner will be revealed at the end of the Autumn Fayre event, and will be promoted on St Nicks' website and social media platforms afterwards.
- Besides publicity, the contest winner will also receive a **certificate and bottle of wine**.
- Entries must be dropped off at St Nicks Environment Centre by **12:30pm on Sat 11th October**.
